# One Pager Instructions

Objective: Create a visually appealing and informative article-analysis one pager

Layout:

- Center Box: Article information - Write the title of the article, the author, and the source information (website name, publication name, etc).
- Top Left: Article Summary – Write a succinct, detailed summary of the article in 3-4 sentences.
- Top Right: Visual Representation – Draw a symbol, image, or cartoon that depicts the topic or main idea of the article.
- Bottom Left: Vocabulary – Choose 3-4 words in the article that you didn't understand. Write the words and their definitions in a visually appealing manner. (consider fun colors, different sizing, or fun fonts)
- Bottom Right: Critical Thinking – How does this article connect to your life, something you've learned in class, or to the world today? Write at least 3-4 sentences.

Tips and Tricks:

- Use colors and creative fonts for an engaging design.
- Keep information accurate and neat.
